

THE MATTERHORN: THE MOUNTAIN OF MOUNTAINS

The Matterhorn – mystical, majestic, the mountain of mountains. No one can escape its fascination, neither locals or guests. This is why the makers of Zermatt Open-Air Theatre chose it as the backdrop for the open-air stage. Every evening new facets of the mountain can be discovered, every minute the spectacle of light and shadow changes, but it always captivates the audience with its splendour.

THE STORY

The year is 1865: that year in the history of Zermatt when the farming world ended and tourism started to boom.

Edward Whymper is horrified: his Italian mountain guide, Jean-Antoine Carrel, has just betrayed him and begun the ascent from the Italian side without him. Whymper feels deceived and at once puts together a group for an immediate attempt to climb the mountain from Zermattvia the Hörnli ridge.

Seven men - consisting of two Zermatt and one French mountain guide, as well as four noble mountaineers from England, - set off from Zermatt to the summit on Friday morning July, 13 1865.

There is unrest in the village: for many, wanting to climb a mountain which is considered to be invincible on a Friday, 13th, amounts to an invitation to the devil. But contrary to all superstitions and fears, it is observed down in the village that all seven men

have arrived at the summit unharmed.
